'it's my son. He likes photography and I'm not sure how to help him. I thought if you might take his picture, he might start to talk with you about it and he might learn a little from you.' 'We'll do it Saturday,' I told the drummer. 'Saturday?' he repeated. 'Saturday,' I repeated.'"
