### Description

This custom printed photograph postcard depicts an automobile parked on a dirt road carrying six women and two men as passengers. The automobile appears to resemble a REO Model B, which were made between 1905 and 1907. The image is captioned: "On the road to Orange County Park. Ruth Taylor early day milliner a passenger." Another photograph from this collection indicates that one of the men in the photo is named Abe Hendricks. Orange County Park, now known as Irvine Regional Park, was and still is a popular day destination for picnicing and enjoying nature. The caption indicates these automobiles have made the approximately 8-mile trip from Santa Ana to the park much more feasible.
