Description

Carl Jonnevold, of Norwegian birth, moved to San Francisco in 1887 where he maintained a studio for many years. "Untitled" is typical of the intimate-sized landscapes he painted in the Barbizon School vein. The Barbizon School consisted of a group of naturalist landscape painters who worked in the vicinity of a small village on the outskirts of Paris by the same name.
