Seated ceramic figure with turtle carapace and striker, Nayarit style, West Mexican Shaft Tomb Culture (possibly Etzatlón region of Jalisco, Mexico). Seated figure with crossed legs, holding a shell in left hand and a three-pronged instrument in the right hand. Mouth open, three earrings, and a domed hat.
