Seated ceramic figure with turtle carapace and striker, Nayarit style, West Mexican Shaft Tomb Culture (possibly Etzatlon region of Jalisco, Mexico). Seated figure with crossed legs, holding a shell in left hand and a threepronged instrument in the right hand. Mouth open, three earrings, and a domed hat.
