Complete uniform includes jacket, trousers, folding overseas hat, and leg wrappings or long socks. According to the donor, Mr. Bowland enlisted in South Dakota, went overseas in a Depot Battalion and was transferred to the Signal Corps after his arrival in France. A. Division Mark (First Army), Gold Stripe (foreign service), Red Stripe (discharge). Rank: Master Electrician (Flags, hand full lightning).
