



## Pipe Bag

Porcupine quill, string, horse hair, deer hide, and glass beads

### Description

Large deerskin and bead pipe bag. Beads of dark and light blue, red, green, and yellow. Six triangular hanging sections, fringed, with metal cones (tinklers) and horsehair. Tiestrings of porcupine quills.
