## Spear

Date mid 20th Century Primary Maker Asmat Medium Wood and pigment

## Description

A dark brown wooden spear collected from the Papua Province (Irian Jaya) of Indonesia and dates back to the mid-20th century. The Asmat are well known for their intricately carved and elegantly adorned spears. Carved out of single piece of light wood this spear presents an openwork panel about a third of the way up the shaft. The panel features a repeating "x" pattern with incised coiled designs at the center--that may be a symbolic depiction of the cuscus tail. Two pairs of barbs found just under the spear top are aerodynamic in shape and are designed to accurately pierce the intended target.
