Navajo rug in the Early Crystal Trading Post regional style made c. 1920. Woven of hand spun wool warp and weft. Carded gray, natural white and brown, and vegetal dyed medium brown wool. With eight whirling log or swastika motifs and serrated border Striking use of carded gray wool and lazy lines which create beackground to foreground interplay and depth. -Per Matt Wood, Appraiser
