

## Description

An etching of two nude female figures reveals Raul Anguiano's transition to portraiture following his rejection of political art inspired by Mexican muralists Diego Rivera, José Clemente Orozco, and David Alfaro Siqueiros. From 2001 to 2006, Anguiano taught in the Santa Ana Unified School District, suggesting that this work was likely produced in California. This print is number 38/50.
