## Description

This unique object requires more research, but appears to be a multicolored staff with panels of red, black, and offwhite pigment. It was collected by the donor in the Trobriand Islands of Papua New Guinea's Milne Bay Province. At its top, the object has a carved circular hole which may have been used to tie other adornments to the staff such as feathers, shells, and woven plant fiber ornaments.
